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Consent for medical treatment

(For non-Japanese patients)

The medical treatment expenses for “patients who do not possess Japanese citizenship and do not have any valid public health insurance in Japan” will be calculated at a rate of 10 yen per point.

As indicated in a notification from the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare, “Expenses for Treatments at Medical Institutions, Including Social Medical Corporations, Provided to Foreigners Who Are Temporally Staying in Japan,” the following services will be charged as those that are not directly related to medical treatments.

- Administrative expenses for international communication about patient information necessary for providing examinations/treatments.
- Expenses, including interpretation fees, for patients who cannot understand Japanese.

As the total expense for both the aforementioned services, **outpatients will be charged 11,000 yen (tax excluded)** and **inpatients 12,000 yen per day (tax excluded)**.

In addition, translation fees for documents, including medical certificates, required for an insurance claim and other requests in your own country, will be charged separately.
